Business Leaders Lack Confidence in Emerging Risk Resilience

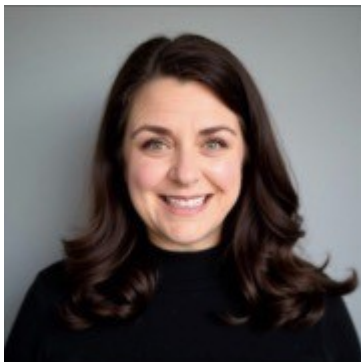
